

Fuse Events – Teen Disco Terms & Conditions

By purchasing a ticket and completing the registration process, parents/guardians confirm that they have read, understood, and agree to the following Terms & Conditions.

1. Tickets & Entry

- All tickets must be purchased in advance.
 - Tickets are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled by Fuse Events.
 - Tickets may not be resold or transferred without prior approval.

2. Age & Admission

- This event is strictly for teens within the advertised age range.
 - Proof of age may be requested on entry.
 - Fuse Events reserves the right to refuse entry if age requirements are not met.

3. Dress Code

- Teens must be dressed appropriately in smart, clean attire.
 - Tracksuit bottoms, offensive clothing, or inappropriate dress are not permitted.
 - Fuse Events reserves the right to refuse entry based on unsuitable attire.

4. Zero Tolerance Policy

- This is a strictly alcohol, vape, smoking, and drug-free event.
 - Any teen found in possession of, or suspected of being under the influence of alcohol, vapes, or drugs will be refused entry or removed from the event immediately.
 - Parents/guardians will be contacted for immediate collection.

5. Behaviour

- Respectful behaviour towards staff and other attendees is expected at all times.
 - Aggressive, disruptive, or unsafe behaviour will result in removal from the event.
 - No refunds will be issued in these circumstances.

6. Re-Entry Policy

- Once a teen leaves the premises, re-entry will not be permitted under any circumstances.

7. Personal Belongings

- There is no cloakroom available.
 - Attendees are advised to bring minimal personal belongings.
 - Fuse Events accepts no responsibility for items that are lost, damaged, or stolen.

8. Leaving the Premises

- Fuse Events is not responsible for teens who leave the venue before the scheduled end time.
 - Responsibility for the teen transfers back to the parent/guardian once the teen exits the premises.

9. Parent / Guardian Availability

- A parent or guardian must remain contactable by phone for the duration of the event.

10. Health & Wellbeing

- Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring their teen is fit to attend the event and for managing any personal health needs.
 - In the event of an emergency, Fuse Events will take appropriate action to ensure the safety of attendees, including contacting emergency services where necessary.

11. Photography & Video

- By purchasing a ticket and completing the registration process, parents/guardians acknowledge and agree that photographs and video footage may be taken during the event.
 - These images may be used for promotional and marketing purposes, including on social media platforms and future event advertising.

12. Event Changes or Cancellation

- Fuse Events reserves the right to make changes to the event, including timings or venue, where necessary.

- In the unlikely event of cancellation, ticket holders will be notified and refunds issued where applicable.

13. Liability

- Attendance is at the teen's own risk.
 - Fuse Events, its staff, and venue partners shall not be held liable for any loss, injury, or damage sustained during the event, except where required by law.

- By purchasing a ticket and completing the registration form, parents/guardians confirm acceptance of these Terms & Conditions in full.
